# 50<sup>™</sup> DIMITRIA OPENING

Motivated by the International Year of Light initiative, the opening event visually connects the White Tower and Maison Crystal with the Port of Thessaloniki. An imaginary bridge is going to unify those three crucial spots with video projections, alternations of shape and color, monument illuminations and light installations. Boats will carry citizens from the seafront esplanade to the Passenger Terminal of the Harbor Organization, whereas a spectacular projection is going to highlight the building architecture. A musical journey will run alongside the event, from the White Tower all the way to the Port, featuring Agios Lavrentios Brass Band, a group based in Pelion, consisting of 9 brass, horn and drums musicians from New Zealand, Australia, Canada, Greece, Portugal, Germany and Italy. A musical feast from the heart of Serbia to New Orlean's Mardi Gras! The big party of the Dimitria Opening will take place in the Port's Jetty A.

With five important works of performance / installation ("The ship of Fools", "The Book of Dust", "The Book of Blood", "Ghost Letters", "Passion/Flower"), Leibniz Live Art Company, co-founded by Ernst Fischer and Helen Spackman in 2005, is an art collective that aims to present socially engaged and interactive work that addresses issues of home and belonging with a close interest in bio-ethical and ecological concerns. In their numerous projects and collaborations, performance is utilized as an accessible and vibrant means of countercultural documentation and regeneration. Their performance in Thessaloniki is titled: «The Book Of Blood: Human Writes», and the words Right and Write are at its core. They will be replaced in order to multiply their meaning and references. The performance also requires the participant's donation of a single drop of blood, which shall be used as contribution to a unique version of the United Declaration of Human Rights, one that travels from venue to venue throughout the world. Additionally and in the same venue, 10 Greek performance artists will present politically inspired performances, under instructions from the Leibniz Live Art Company, who will already have guided participants to an intensive workshop.

A multi-instrumentalist whose vast creative outlet encompasses bass guitar, electric and acoustic guitar, percussion, violophone, ukulele, vibraphone, melodica, music boxes and Wurlitzer piano, as well as an accomplished composer of renowned discography, widely known through the Your Hand In Mine orchestral duo, Manos Mylonakis embarks on a journey of personal creative expression. # DADA CINEMA AND MUSIC

Three of the most exceptional duos within the greek alternative and experimental music scene, Silent Move, Sancho 003 and Underwater Chess, compose and perform their own score for avant garde european film standards of the mid-20th century and the Dada movement. Silent Moves are experienced enough and well accustomed with the genre. Their roots in improvisation and special effects are ideal for sonic explorations in cinema. Band members are Giannis Paxevanis (guitar, loops, tapes) and Vasilis Tzavaras (piano, guitar, loops, tapes). Sancho 003, the duo of Fotis Siotas and Kostas Pandelis rely on violin, loops and a wide array of electronics in order to produce an equally ethereal and bombastic musical experience. The sonic "cast" of those cinematic explorations is completed with Underwater Chess, the duo of Panos Papazoglou and Mihalis Vrettas, a band that incorporates guitar, loops, violin and vocals to an amazing result. The project will be evolved around films by legends of the silver screen.
